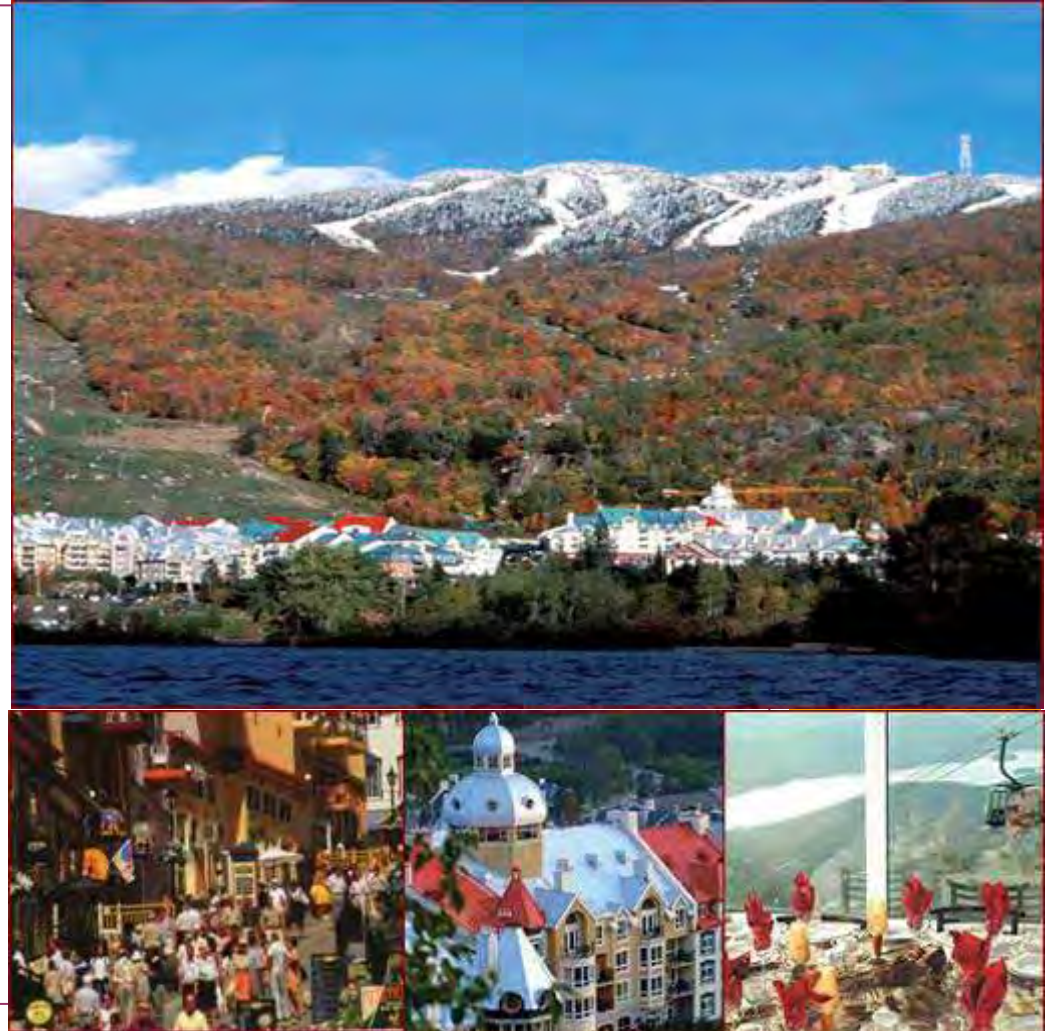

- Banquet facilities for all type of functions

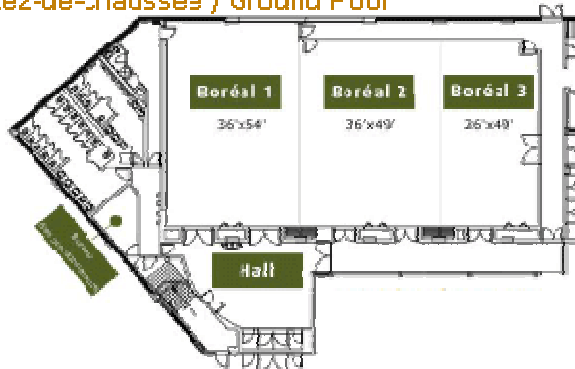

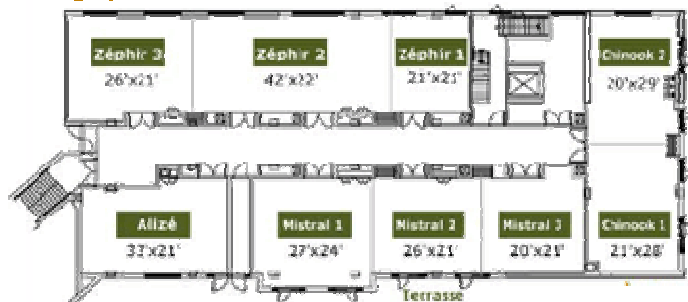
# Convention Centre Room Layout

- Symphony of Colors

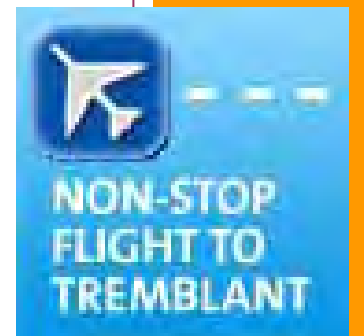




# Getting There
