Thank you for your participation in the Sponsor Ballot of P802.16c/D3. The ballot closed on 11 September 2002. The results are, in summary:

- 37 Approve
- 1 Disapprove
- 4 Abstain
- 6 Not Voting

By virtue of these numbers, the ballot is considered to have passed, pending comment recirculation. We received 40 comments; eighteen of which were marked "technical." Resolutions were developed by a Ballot Resolution Committee chaired by Ken Stanwood. The single Disapprove voter submitted only one comment (#10), which was editorial and was accepted in essence.

We are requesting that the IEEE Balloting Center initiate a ten-day recirculation of these comments and resolutions. Included in this ballot package, please find:
