Dear P1802.16.1 Balloting Group:

Thank you for your participation in the Sponsor Ballot of P1802.16.1/D2. The ballot closed on 25 February 2003. The results are, in summary:

41	Approve
0	Disapprove
1	Abstain
12	Not Voting

By virtue of these numbers, the ballot is considered to have passed, pending recirculation of changes to the draft. We received 37 comments, of which 22 were editorial and none were disapprove comments. Resolutions were developed by a Ballot Resolution Committee composed of Task Group C of the IEEE 802.16 Working Group on Broadband Wireless Access. The committee, chaired by Ken Stanwood, met at a regular session of the IEEE 802.16 Working Group on Broadband Wireless Access on 12-15 May 2003; the full Working Group later unanimously approved the resolutions in its Closing Plenary. Reviewing these results, the IEEE 802 Sponsor Executive Committee granted conditional approval to close the Sponsor Ballot and send the draft to RevCom for approval. Accordingly, this ballot is being conducted under the procedure for conditional approval of the IEEE 802 Operating Rules <<http://ieee802.org/rules.pdf>>.

We are requesting that the IEEE Balloting Center initiate a fifteen-day recirculation of the comment resolutions (**80216-03\_08r2.pdf**) and of the resulting new draft P1802.16.1/D3 (**P1802161\_D3.pdf**). We are including the full new draft in the ballot package. However, please understand that the scope of this recirculation includes not the entire draft but only the portions that changed as a result of the comment resolution. Please take this opportunity to review the package. You are not obligated to reply; if you do not, your current vote will stand. Based on the changes to the draft or on the Disapprove comments and responses, you may change your vote and/or submit additional comments. If you wish to re-vote or comment, please keep the deadline in mind. Instructions have been provided by the IEEE Balloting Center.
