Reason for Group's Decision/Resolution

The Working Group has already responded to an SCC14 Coordination Comment from John T. Scott on this issue, and he has accepted our response.

Mr. Frysinger is following up on an SCC14 Coordination Comment that he submitted previously in a different ballot (P802.16e). In that case, the 802.16 Working Group suggested that the issue would best be handled in the P802.16-2004/Cor1 ballot. The WG also provided Mr. Frysinger with the explicit response to Mr. Scott's comment. Mr. Frysinger responded with a rather detailed note accepting this resolution [see IEEE 802.16-05/059r2 http://ieee802.org/16/docs/05/80216-05_059r2.pdf, pages 8-10].

In Mr. Frysinger's detailed note in the P802.16e ballot, he mentioned in regard to FED-STD-1037C that "I must trust that the baseline document includes the citation in its bibliography or references." This item was not submitted in or transmitted to the P802.16-2004/Cor1 ballot process for consideration, until now.

At this time, Mr. Frysinger is suggesting that we "Add FED-STD-1037C to the list of references or to the bibliography." We accept the comment, in principle. However, we do not believe that this response warrants another recirculation. We would be happy to communicate to the IEEE-SA editorial staff a request for the implementation of the following editorial instruction:
