

- Ball Room: optional for plenary if total registration goes beyond 400 people.







VISA Issues

- Majority of members are visa exempt; contact window will be provided in the future meeting
- VISA Exempt: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei Darussalam, Canada, Costa Rica, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Iceland, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Monaco, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Singapore, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, U.K. and U.S.A. (with >= 6 months validation period)
- Landing VISA: US Passport valid period <6 months
- China VISA (see next page)
