

1. VISA EXEMPT

- Nationals from countries under the visa-exempt program are allowed to travel to Taiwan for up to 14 days without obtaining a visa.
 - Visa Exempt Countries:
 - Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, *Ireland, Italy, *Japan, Republic of Korea, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Monaco, the Netherlands, *New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, *U.K., U.S.A. and Vatican City State.

2. LANDING VISA



- Nationals from several countries are eligible to obtain a landing visa at the visa office of consular affairs bureau at the Taiwan Taoyuan international airport.
 - Eligible countries for application: Czech Republic, Hungary, and Poland.

Requirements:

- (1) a passport valid for at least six months at the time of entry.
- (2) a confirmed return air ticket or an air ticket and a visa for the next destination, and a confirmed seat reservation for his (her) departure.
- (3) fill out an application form with a photo.
- (4) visa fee of NT\$ 1,600 (citizens of countries with reciprocal agreements shall be issued visas gratis) plus a handling fee of NT\$ 800; (approximately USD 80)
- (5) no criminal record verified by the airport police

3. Entry Visa

For those participants whose countries are not of visa exempt countries nor are eligible for landing visa, they shall apply an Entry Visa.

Requirements:

- 1. contact local R.O.C. Embassy or Consulate
- 2. a passport valid for at least six months at the time of entry.
- 3. a confirmed return air ticket or an air ticket and a visa for the next destination, and a confirmed seat reservation for his (her) departure.
- 4. fill out an application form with a photo.

4. Visa for PRC citizens

- A Taiwan VISA is required to apply for an exit permit from China government.
- It is advisable to apply the visa early as the process can as long as 6 weeks.
