IEEE 802.16 License-Exempt Task Group

Deadline: 10 March 2005

On 8 December 2004, the IEEE-SA Standards Board approved the creation of the IEEE 802.16h Task Group on License Exempt Coexistence. The PAR and 5Criteria are included in:

http://ieee802.org/16/docs/04/80216-04_56r1.pdf, defining the following scope:

“This amendment specifies improved mechanisms, as policies and medium access control enhancements, to enable coexistence among license-exempt systems based on IEEE Standard 802.16 and to facilitate the coexistence of such systems with primary users”.
