

## Working Group Review: P802.16h Working Document

## **IEEE 802.16 License-Exempt Task Group**

Deadline: 2 May 2006

IEEE 802.16's License-Exempt (LE) Task Group <a href="http://ieee802.org/16/le">http://ieee802.org/16/le</a> is working to develop a draft under the P802.16h PAR, which was approved by the IEEE-SA Standards Board on 8 December 2004. The PAR:

has the following scope statement: "This amendment specifies improved mechanisms, as policies and medium access control enhancements, to enable coexistence among license-exempt systems based on IEEE Standard 802.16 and to facilitate the coexistence of such systems with primary users."

The Task Group has been maintaining a pre-draft Working Document. The current version is available as IEEE 802.16h-06/010:

At Session#42, the IEEE 802.16 WG approved a motion to submit the latest working document to a formal Working Group Review. At this stage, no formal vote is required, and there is no working group membership implication. However, participants are strongly encouraged to review the document in preparation for an upcoming decision on adopting the working document as a draft standard and subjecting it to a WG letter ballot.

Note that the strikeouts on the document are indicative of the fact that it is not a draft standard.
