Following previous correspondence on matters of interest to the IEEE 802.16 Working Group and the WiMAX Forum, we would like to inform you of the activities during our Session #61 of March 2009.

IEEE 802.16 is pleased to inform you that IEEE has approved for submission to the ITU-R the following documents prepared by the IEEE 802.16 WG:

- 1) L802.16-09/0026r1: Response to liaison statement from Working Party 5A on BWA characteristics for use in compatibility studies with Fixed-Satellite Service systems in the 3 400-4 200 MHz band
- 2) L802.16-09/0027r1: Response to liaison statement from Working Party 5D on IMT parameters in the 790-862 MHz band
- 3) L802.16-09/0029r1: Revision of Recommendation ITU-R M.1801
- 4) L802.16-09/0031: On submission of candidate IMT-advanced RIT based on IEEE Project 802.16m
- 5) L802.16-09/0032: Response to liaison statement from Working Party 5A on invitation for contributions on the Proposed Draft New Report ITU-R M.[LMS.PPDR.UHF TECH]
- 6) L802.16-09/0033r2: Update of OFDMA TDD WMAN in Revision 9 of Recommendation ITU-R M.1457
