The IEEE 802.16 Working Group has drafted a Project Authorization Request (PAR) P802.16g to develop a new amendment to IEEE Standard 802.16-2004, as amended by the future 802.16e. The PAR proposal, sponsored by IEEE 802, was recommended for approval on 2 August by the New Standards Committee (NesCom) of the IEEE-SA Standards Board. Final approval by the Board is currently pending and expected to be granted by 12 August 2004.

This document provides enhancements to the MAC and PHY management entities of IEEE Standard 802.16-2004, as amended by P802.16e, to create standardized procedures and interfaces for the management of conformant 802.16 devices.

The IEEE 802.16 Working Group's new Network Management (NetMan) Task Group http://WirelessMAN.org/netman has been assigned to develop the draft. The NetMan Task Group aims to create a first draft by the end of Session #34 http://WirelessMAN.org/meetings/mtg34.

Contributions will be considered non-confidential and will be posted for public access on the IEEE 802.16 Web Site http://WirelessMAN.org. Contribution document naming format will follow the standard IEEE 802.16 naming convention using 'g' for the project designation, with the format 'C802.16g-04/ij'.
