On 12 August 2004, the IEEE-SA Standards Board gave final approval to the IEEE 802.16 Working Group Project Authorization Request (PAR) P802.16g to develop a new amendment to IEEE Standard 802.16-2004, as amended by the future 802.16e.

This document provides enhancements to the MAC and PHY management entities of IEEE Standard 802.16-2004, as amended by P802.16e, to create standardized procedures and interfaces for the management of conformant 802.16 devices.
The IEEE 802.16 Working Group's new Network Management (NetMan) Task Group [http://WirelessMAN.org/netman](http://WirelessMAN.org/netman) has been assigned to develop the draft. The NetMan Task Group aims to create a first draft by the end of Session \#34 [http://WirelessMAN.org/meetings/mtg34](http://WirelessMAN.org/meetings/mtg34).

This Call for Contributions requests input relevant to the draft. The Call for Contributions shall be limited to material related to table of contents for initial draft, skeleton document, and/or network architecture reference models.

Contributions will be considered non-confidential and will be posted for public access on the IEEE 802.16 Web Site [http://WirelessMAN.org](http://WirelessMAN.org). Contribution document naming format will follow the standard IEEE 802.16 naming convention using ' g ' for the project designation, with the format ' $\mathrm{C} 802.16 \mathrm{~g}-04 / \mathrm{ij}$ '.
