#### DO YOU NEED A VISA TO ENTER CANADA?

A Visa may be required for entrance into the CANADA. #### WHEN SHOULD YOU APPLY FOR VISA TO ENTER CANADA?

You should apply for your CANADA Visa well in advance the session you wish to attend to have a reasonable chance of getting your Visa in time.

#### **USA Attendees**

Requirements for Travelers from the United States

As of 1 June 2009, EVERYONE traveling between the United States and Canada, Mexico, Central and South America, the Caribbean, and Bermuda by LAND, SEA (including cruises and ferries) or AIR will be required to present a valid passport or other documents as determined by the Department of Homeland Security to cross the border.

#### Vancouver International Airport (YVR) Transportation

**Canada Line:** The Canada Line connects Vancouver International Airport (YVR) to downtown Vancouver in under 30 minutes. Cost is \$CDN 3.75 for adults and \$CDN 2.50 for children each way, plus a \$CDN 5.00 surcharge for all trips originating at the airport.
