 - Produced recommendations for working group consideration
- Reviewed D0.6
 - captured two pages of editing instructions, recorded in the minutes - Howard Frazier and John Hawkins will implement
- Decided to launch a task force review of the draft after this meeting
- Will request a full day of meeting time in September

802.3.1 recommendations on downloadable content

- This plan depends on IEEE-SA buy-in
- One site maintained by 802.3 for all downloadable/machine readable extracts (802.3 content on the two IEEE-SA sites maintained but identified as superseded)
 - Base for this is IEEE Std 802.3-2008
 - Amendments as part of the standard go in the same folder
 - Any current amendment projects should use this approach
 - We need to include online content in pre-publication review
 - Define a sensible file naming convention (needs more work) to minimize publication errors
 - Include unambiguous two way association in both the standard and the external document
 - Define a consistent citation format to minimize errors in transition from ballot to publication and current to superseded
- Do not include the current downloadable PICS on the new site
- Maintain superseded content on our site in the future
 - Annex 30C (Link Agg MIB module) needs to be labeled as superseded
- Precedence must be stated for each citation
- The online content should be part of the ballot package
