Main remaining issues

MIB

- Brian Hassink (MIB editor) has produced a new MIB, based on draft 3.0 and the resolutions of ballot comments on D2.2
 - ▶ This will be incorporated into the next draft
- sysUpTime object (in 12.17.1.1.3)
 - I think this should this simply be deleted (per ballot comments)
- Virtualisation of MIB
 - Now that there is a T-component intended for use in BEBs, does the MIB need to have additional indices or other changes?
- Should the TPMR-mib be separate or a subset of the Q-MIB?
 - Some objects are duplicated.

PICS

It seems that the draft is reasonably stable, so now is a good time for the PICS to be added.





MAC Status Protocol (MSP) issues

- Should MSP be allowed on Q-bridge ports in general? This is proposed in Mick's paper and seems sensible.
 - How would this be accomplished?
- Text is required to describe the interaction of MSP with shared media LANs.
 - Where should such text appear?





Plan

- Generate 802.1aj/D3.1 following this meeting, incorporating
 - Revised MIB
 - **PICS**
 - Changes agreed this week
- Submit this for WG recirculation ballot based on the vote taken at the July 2008 plenary.
- Comment resolution at the November plenary
- Perhaps we can get approval to go to sponsor ballot following the November meeting.
 - ▶ This may depend on resolution of the MIB indexing issue.
