Other than the purely editorial changes made to the draft by the IEEE Project Editor, the changes made below were made after the third recirculation ballot and have not been seen by the sponsor pool.

1. The Ministry of Post and Telecommunications of Japan has withdrawn MPT notice 759, 1992. They requested that its reference in the standard ("(e.g., Japan in MPT notice No. 759,1992 for the content for identification signals as meant in Article 25 of the ITU Radio Regulations)") be removed. The quoted text was removed from the draft.
2. Certain misspellings were corrected.
3. An informative reiteration of a factor defined in a normative clause (aMPDUDurationFactor) was updated to match the normative definition.

In the opinion of the task group, all of these changes are editorial in nature and do not affect any implementations that may have been made based on the draft that was the object of the recirculation ballot.
