IEEE 802.16's License-Exempt (LE) Task Group <<u>http://wirelessman.org/le></u> is working to develop a draft under the P802.16h PAR, which was approved by the IEEE-SA Standards Board on 8 December 2008. The PAR:

has the following scope statement: "This amendment specifies improved mechanisms, as policies and medium access control enhancements, to enable coexistence among license-exempt systems based on IEEE Standard 802.16 and to facilitate the coexistence of such systems with primary users."

The Task Group has been maintaining a pre-draft Working Document. This was considerably revised at the Working Group's Session #37. The current version is available as IEEE 802.16h-05/013:

Contributions are currently requested addressing the following topics:

#### 1. Security approach

During Session #37, two possible approaches were discussed and temporarily included in the Working Document: one using RADIUS and another using IPSEC with the key exchange based on IKEv2. Contributions addressing the security solution and/or comments on the advantages/disadvantages of the proposed solutions are requested.

# 2. Coexistence Protocol message format

The text in the Working Document should be consolidated based on contributions addressing the message format.

# 3. Text for the IEEE P802.16h draft, according to the Table of Contents of the Working Document.

# 4. Other topics that are relevant for 802.16h PAR.
