Regarding your two email notes suggesting possible methods for providing HIPERACCESS participants access to 802.16 documents, no objection was voiced within the Working Group to your suggested Plan 2, in which you would track participation in recent HIPERACCESS meetings in terms of attendance at the opening & closing HA Plenary. I understand that you have not yet committed to the administrative burden this might entail, and I look forward to hearing your current thoughts on this.
