We understand that, at the meeting of IEEE 802.18 Working Group of 15 March 2007, it was agreed to establish an 802.18 correspondence group, which will hold weekly conference calls with the chairs of the concerned working groups in IEEE 802, or their delegates, to develop an IEEE draft contribution to ITU-R Working Party 8F on IMT-Advanced requirements.

The 802.16 Working Group appreciates the constructive dialogue within IEEE 802.18 this week and is very interested in contributing to these activities. We are pleased to offer to host a correspondence e-mail reflector for this activity.

Furthermore, the 802.16 working group offers Document IEEE L802.16-07/017 for adoption by the 802.18 correspondence group as the basis for developing the draft contribution to ITU-R WP 8F on IEEE-proposed IMT-Advanced requirements.

Considering the ITU-R deadline for contributions and the time required for approvals, we also propose the following schedule:

- 21 March start of 802.18 conference calls (assume Tuesdays)
 27 March second conference call
 3 April third conference call
 10 April fourth conference call
 17 April fifth and last conference call
 20 April target for completion of 802.18 draft contribution
 25 April initiation of EC ballot
 13 May completion of EC ballot
 14 May IEEE-SA approval
- 16 May contribution due to ITU, 16:00 hours GMT
