Call for Contributions on Project 802.16d:

IEEE Standard 802.16: 2-11 GHz System Profiles and Corrections of Errors in Base Standard

Deadline: 10 January 2003

On 11 December 2003, the IEEE-SA Standards Board approved Project Authorization Request (PAR) P802.16d to develop an amendment to IEEE Standard 802.16 (as amended by IEEE 802.16a and 802.16c). The PAR (IEEE 802.16-02/47r1 http://ieee802.org/16/docs/02/80216-02_47r1.pdf) has the scope statement:

This Amendment updates and expands Clause 12 of IEEE Std 802.16, which concerns system profiles that list sets of features and functions to be used in typical implementation cases. Errors and inconsistencies in IEEE Std 802.16 will also be corrected. The scope is limited to 2-11 GHz.

A new 802.16 Task Group d http://ieee802.org/16/tgd has been assigned to develop the draft. In order to accommodate the PAR's anticipated Sponsor Ballot initiation in July 2003, Task Group d intends to create a first draft by the end of Session #24 in March 2003 and open a Working Group Letter Ballot immediately thereafter.

This Call for Contributions requests input to further the work of Task Group d; contributions are solicited on the following topics:

- Content of Chapter 12 of the air interface specification regarding 2-11 GHz system profiles.
- Errata in IEEE 802.16a or 802.16c, or those in 802.16 not corrected in 802.16a or 802.16c.

Contributions will be considered non-confidential and will be posted for public access on the 802.16 Web Site http://WirelessMAN.org.
