IEEE Standard 802.16: 2-11 GHz System Profiles and Corrections of Errors in Base Standard

Deadline: 7 March 2003

Task Group d <<http://ieee802.org/16/tgd>> of the IEEE 802.16 Working Group on Broadband Wireless Access is leading the development of a draft document under IEEE PAR 802.16d. In order to accommodate the PAR's anticipated Sponsor Ballot initiation in July 2003, Task Group d intends to create a **first draft by the end of Session #24 in March 2003** and open a Working Group Letter Ballot immediately thereafter.

This Call for Contributions requests input on the following topics in the form of specific comments regarding working document IEEE 802.16d-03/01 <http://ieee802.org/16/tgd/docs/80216d-03_01.pdf>.

- 2-11 GHz system profiles, to be modeled on those in IEEE Standard 802.16c.
- Errata in IEEE 802.16a or 802.16c, or those in 802.16 not corrected in 802.16a or 802.16c.
