Sanya, China 24 – 27 January, 2005

Introductions were made and administrative information provided. Chair indicated intent to move the Task Group to complete resolution of the comments received from the Sponsor Ballot Resolution Group and authorize creation of a new Draft. He then presented the TGe Opening Report (802.16e-05/001).

After discussion the motion

Passed: unanimously

Motion 6: To present the following motion to the Working Group;

"To accept IEEE 802.16-04/69r4 and IEEE 802.16-05/001r2 (which supersedes IEEE 802.16-04/69r4 in case of conflict) as the Sponsor Ballot comment resolutions, develop Draft P802.16e/D6 based on those resolutions, and initiate Sponsor Ballot Recirculation" So Moved: John Humbert, Seconded: Randall Schwartz.

Passed: unanimously

The Chair then indicated that in order to properly prepare the Sponsor Ballot Recirculation package, there would be a need for a small number of people to act as a "ballot resolution consolidation" group. This group would take the combined comment resolutions from the two comment databases (802.16-04/60r4 and 802.16-05/001r2) and create a single consolidated comment resolution database that reflects only the original Sponsor Ballot comments. The Chair also volunteered to host this group. After some discussion, it was suggested to table this request until the WG Closing Plenary.

Having no other business, the meeting adjourned at 5:35 PM.
