Contributions should be included only if the Proposed Requirement text is so substantial as to require the contribution format for appropriate presentation. Any contribution shall be referenced by an appropriate comment. Make use of the "TGm" upload directory at <<u>http://tgm.wirelessman.org</u>> to post both comments and contributions.

This is not a ballot, so please do not vote to 'Approve' or 'Disapprove' the document. This is a Call for Comments to improve the document and prepare it for eventual adoption by the Task Group.
