

Call for Comments on Project 802.16m Requirements

Deadline: 9 JULY 2007 AOE

At the IEEE 802.16 Session #49 in May 2007, Task Group m completed its review of a draft of Project 802.16m Requirements document, IEEE 802.16m-07/002r1. All comments received were addressed. An updated version of the document is now available as IEEE 802.16m-07/002r2:

Call for Comments

Task Group m now solicits specific Comments regarding IEEE 802.16m-07/002r2 for discussion and potential adoption during Session #50 in San Francisco. In particular, comments or contributions that revise the document to conform with the latest update to the ITU-R WP8F “IMT-Advanced” requirements are highly desirable. It is anticipated that, by the end of Session #50, the Requirements document will be accepted by the Task Group and used as the basis for development of the draft standard, though it may evolve further in the future.

Submit your comments (with or without associated contributions) by the **deadline of 9 July 2007 AOE** following the instructions at <<http://dot16.org/Commentary>> and <<http://ieee802.org/16/submit.html>>.

Comments should refer to the “Ballot ID” as “tgmreq” and the “Document under Review” as “IEEE 802.16m-07/002r2”.

Contributions should be included only if the proposed requirement text is so substantial as to require the contribution format for appropriate presentation. Any contribution shall be referenced by an appropriate comment. ***Make use of the new IEEE 802.16 Document Submission Template, Rev. 9 (2007-06-17)***
