Discussion: The presenters encouraged participants to look at the suggested wording and consider it to propose wording for PAR scope, need for project, and stakeholders in subsequent meetings or on the reflector. Particularly, there was some discussion on the wording for the need of the project and how to properly capture the development of PHYs optimized for asymmetric peak data rates.

They also pointed out areas where contributions are needed to fill out the CSDs.

In the interest of time, the presentation's content on objectives was abbreviated – participants are encouraged to read and comment on the suggestions there.

A timeline was discussed, largely dependent on progress in Campinas.
