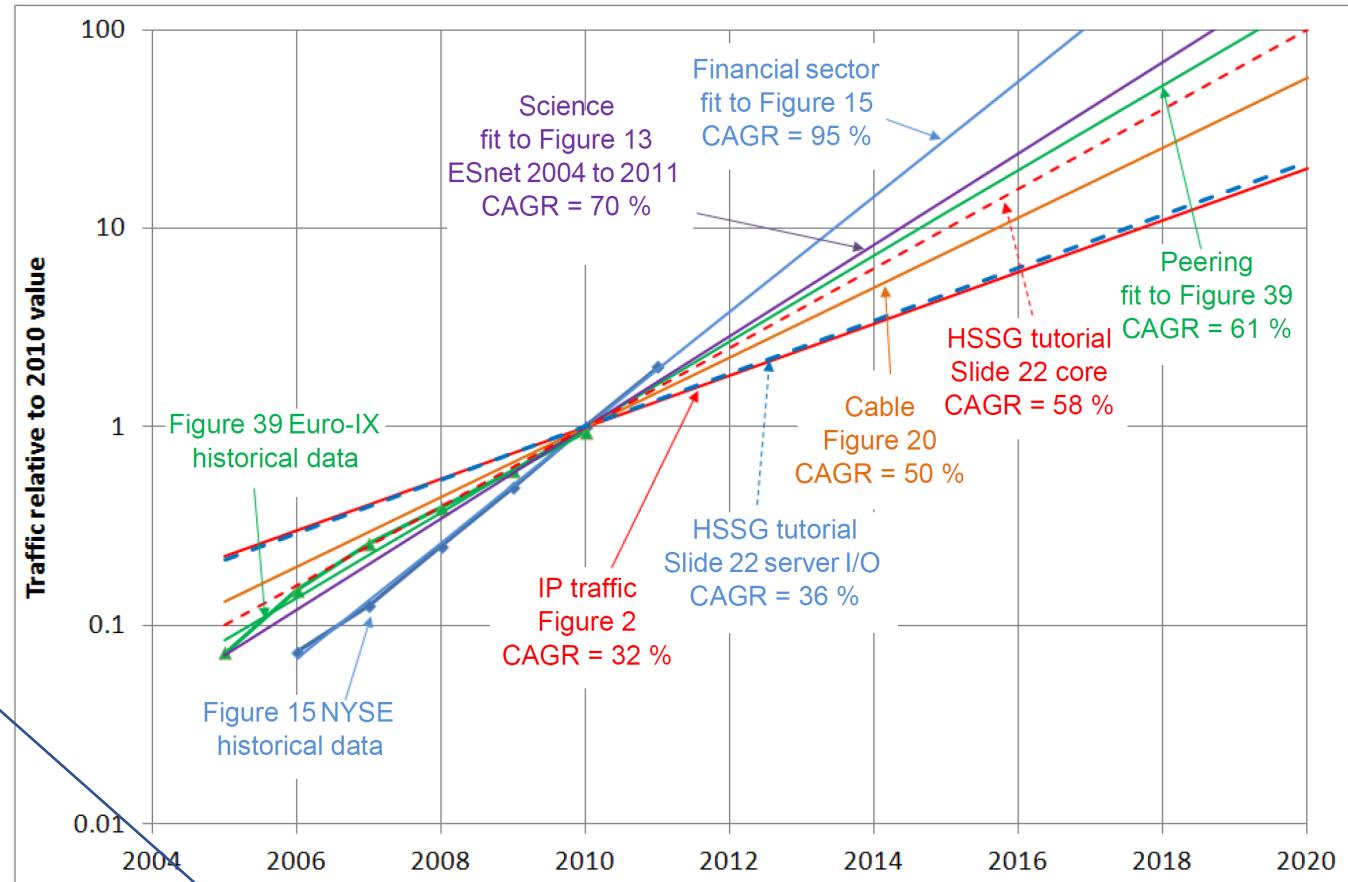
Approach to D1.0 Organization

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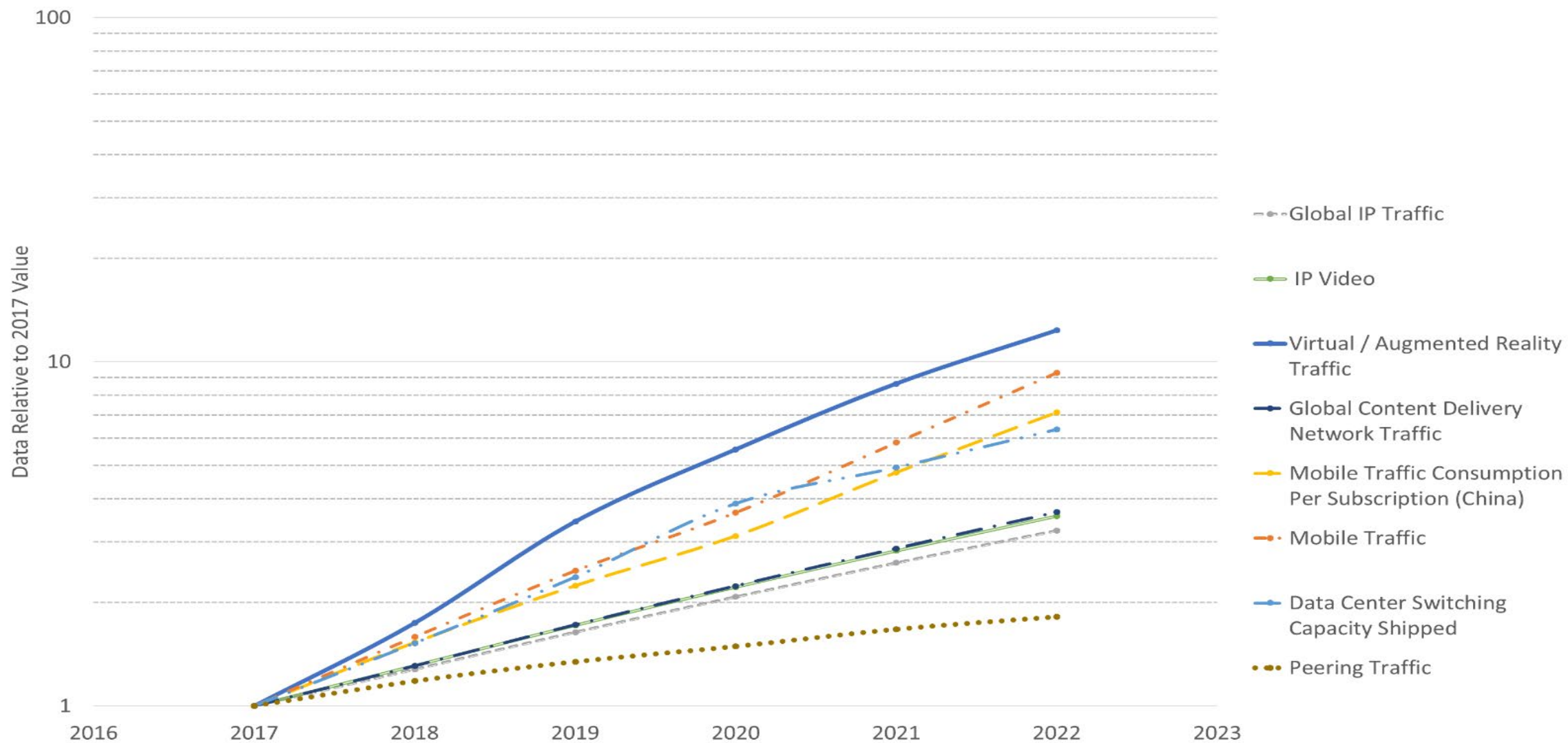
Ethernet BWA (2012) Forecast Comparison



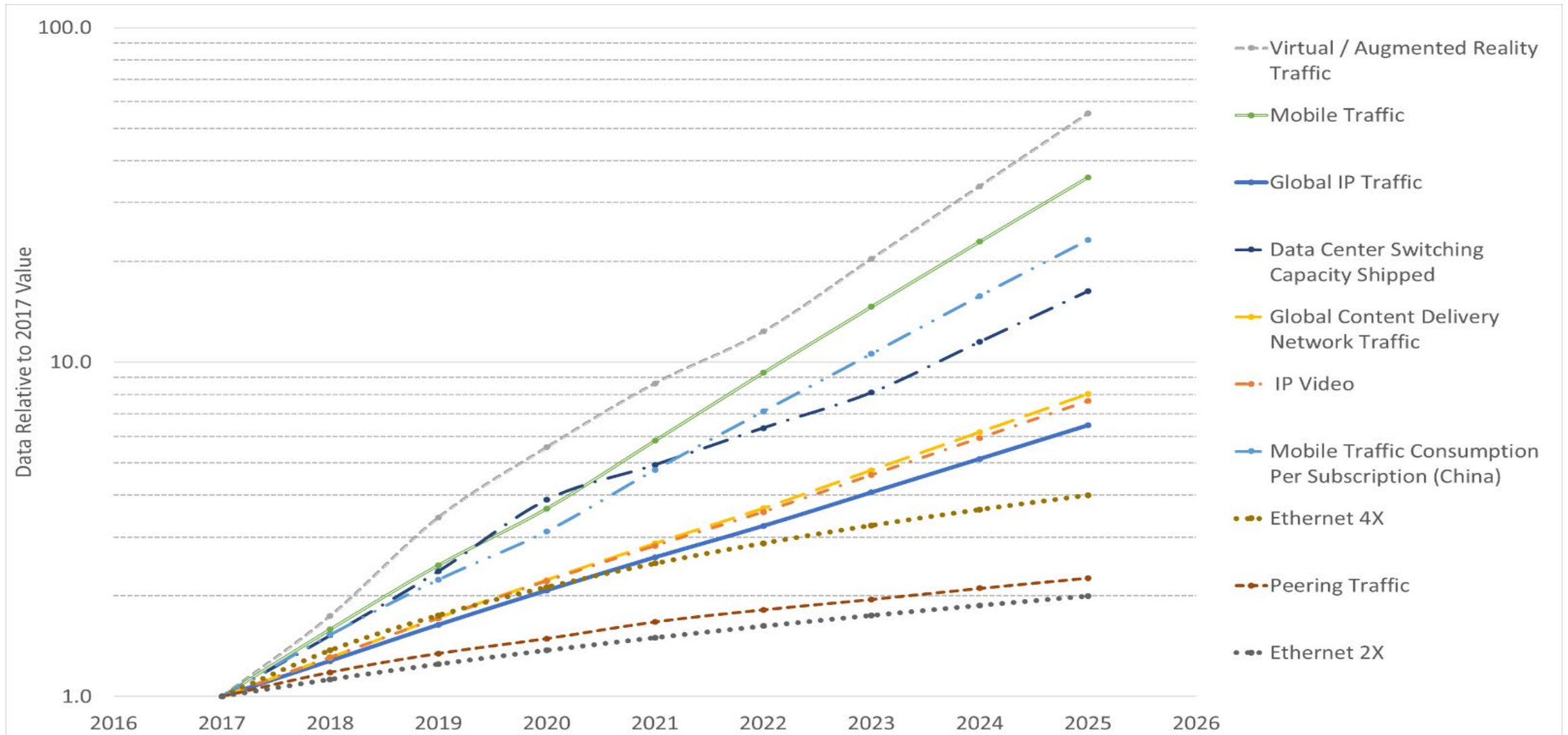

Peering	≈37.5 Tb/s	≈32.5 Tb/s

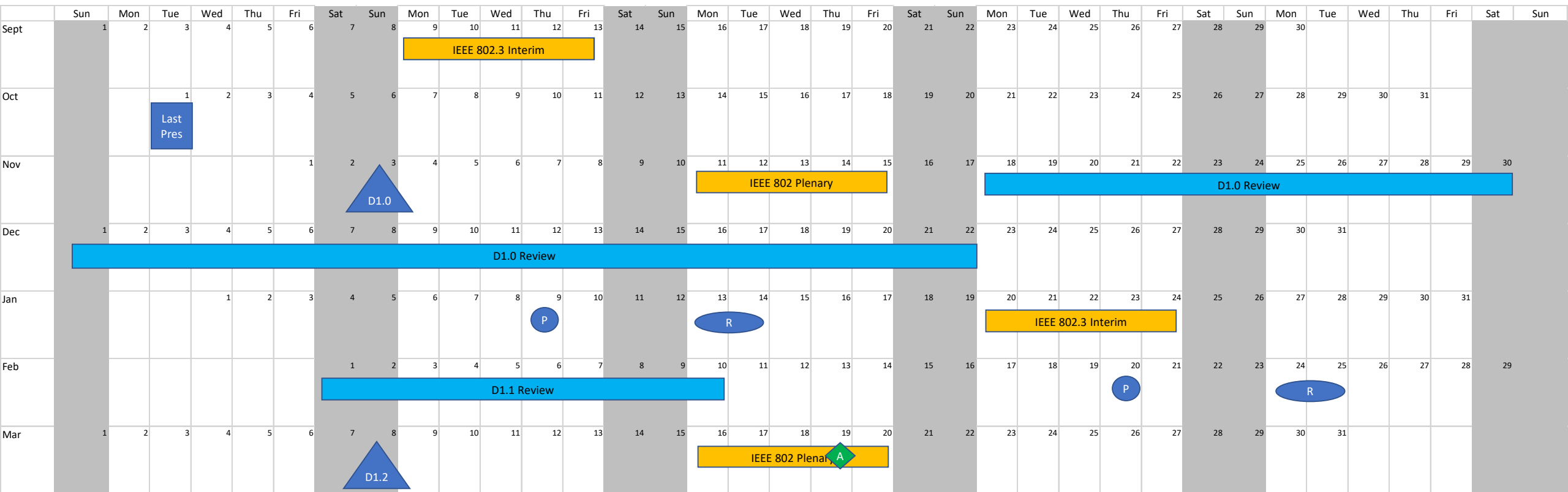
