If large topics remain open, Draft 1.2 is at risk

Comment Status Terminology

- "Open" comments comments that Task Force have not agreed upon a remedy
- "Closed" comments comments that Task Force have agreed upon a remedy
- "Final" comments Task Force has approved motion to adopt the responses to the closed comments

Allow individuals (other than commenter) two business days (AoE, ~67hrs) to request, via the reflector, a "Closed" comment, from the prior meeting only, be considered for re-opening


- Post updated comment database after each meeting









Overview of IEEE 802.3 Standards Process (2/5) – Task Force Comment Phase





Overview of IEEE 802.3 Standards Process (4/5)-Sponsor Ballot Phase


