Edit Name as You Enter...

- When you click "Join" from the calendar invite, you may see a window like this to test your audio.
- Then again, sometimes that doesn't work. This functionality only exists when you are not logged into Webex Meetings and are joining a meeting as a guest user via the Webex Meetings desktop application.
