- ~100 attendees
- Reviewed P802.3ah/D1.414
- Responded to 1537 comments
- Resolved 23 Big Ticket Items

Copper: filled in Annex 62B table, fixed MCM variable, filled in PICs

P2MP: selected closed loop timing, filled in PICS

Optics: new jitter values, temperature bounds, jitter xfer

OAM: package table updated, grouped functions into 7 categories










Adopted timeline
