Subject: Follow up on Management at Scale Projects

This liaison is a follow up to our liaison on WT-505: ONU Management at Scale (LIAISE-595). The issues facing the telecom industry with regards to scale go beyond the management of ONUs extending across the entire Access Network. As such, there is an urgent need to work towards a solution that allows the most efficient usage of standardized YANG models to manage large-scale networks.

Attached is a presentation whose goal is to identify the scale issues currently being experienced as well as some general concepts that are designed to alleviate them. Some of these concepts require investigation into the extensions of how data is modeled that are necessary to achieve the goals.
